FOUNDATION INCREASES GRANT SUPPORT

In August, the Huth Foundation presented a grant award to St. Joseph's School, in Randolph, Oh. This grant, in the amount of \$11,000, and totaling \$35,000 over the years, was accepted by Rev. Thomas Acker S.J., administrator of St. Joseph's School. Founded in 1832 as the first parochial school west of the Alleghenies, St. Joseph's School continues to the present day.

The Foundation Board has also approved a grant of \$5,000 for Open Arms Adoptions (OAA) of Streetsboro, OH. As a private state-licensed, non-profit adoption agency, OAA can use its access and size to bring about real change by creating families through adoption awareness and outreach.

TAX INTELLIGENCE

Congress has made permanent the exclusion from income tax for Individual Retirement Account (IRA) distributions given directly to charity by IRS owners who are over the age of 70 ^{1/2}.

A Qualified Charitable Deduction (QCD) from a traditional IRA is exempt from federal income taxes. In addition, a QCD from your IRA counts towards your required minimum distribution (RMD) and may lower your Adjusted Gross Income (AGI). State income tax rules regarding charitable deductions vary significantly. Several states start with your Federal AGI but do not allow itemized deductions for charitable contributions. If you live in one of these states, you would realize the additional benefit of avoiding state income tax on the IRA charitable contribution.

Don't wait until year end to act. In order to qualify as a QCD, your contribution to the Henry & Laura Huth Charitable Foundation should meet the following requirements:

- ⇒ The transfer must be made directly from your IRA to the charity of your choice on or before December 31 of each calendar year.
- ⇒ The distribution must meet IRS requirements for a 100% deductible charitable donation.
- ⇒ The distribution would otherwise be taxable and annual limits apply.
- ⇒ A distribution from a Roth IRA can meet this requirement, but making QCDs out of a Roth IRA is generally not advisable.
