The Foundation's goal has always been to provide at-risk infants, children and young adults with an opportunity to build a solid foundation, experience positive encouragement and a sense of possibility they need to lead successful, productive lives. Over the years, we have remained true to our founding members' vision by aligning ourselves with like-minded benefactors and partners. The financial generosity and volunteer support given by our friends, family and sponsors has sustained us and we thank all of you for your continued commitment to our cause.

BY THE NUMBERS

Our Board of Directors is made up of 14 dedicated volunteers who donate their time and talents to helping advance the foundation's positive impact on the community.

The majority of our proceeds are used to help move our mission and the foundation's good works forward.

Since 2001, we have donated over \$259,000 to help enrich the lives of children in Akron-Canton community.

Our annual golf invitational will celebrate its 32nd anniversary this year. Over the last 30+ years, we have served over 3,100 hot dogs, gone through 1,200 pounds of potato salad, seen hundreds of Huth logo golf balls land in lakes and woods. Also, we have seen some outstanding low scramble rounds, amazing long drives and closest to the pins...as well as a hole in one.

OPEN ARMS The mission of Open Arms Adoption is to provide a loving and stable home to every child in need. They work tirelessly to create an environment that embraces the unique set of

circumstances each set of birth parents, prospective adoptive parents and children bring.

Approximately 90% of all birth parents and 100% of all families that adopt sibling groups rely upon online research when adoption is considered. Consequently, when Open Arms Adoption reached out for financial assistance to update their website, we were happy to help. Knowing that we have helped our friends at Open Arms Adoption with their mission has been very gratifying for our foundation.

The long-term goal of Project REBUILD is to transform the lives of at-risk individuals through education and job training so that they may become working, productive contributors to the community.

We are proud of our long-standing relationship with Project REBUILD. In 2024, they will utilize our grant to help enhance their alumni engagement/recruitment and membership program. Additionally, our financial assistance will aid in the development of a new entrepreneur/leadership program and help fund a quarterly success recognition program.



A key mission for Saint Mary's Grade School is to prepare and motivate each student while achieving academic success. The school has an outstanding record of success and, with our help, continues to build upon STEM program initiatives.

Last year, Saint Mary's utilized our grant to create a science lab. This year, our grant will allow them to purchase seven new microscopes for their new science lab. We are thrilled to help the bright, young minds

of St. Mary's Grade School thrive in the classroom and embrace STEM program opportunities.

MATCHING FUNDS PROGRAM

In 2023 the Henry and Laura Huth Charitable Foundation re-launched their matching funds program. This program is designed to help organizations, that share our passion, achieve their financial goals. Additionally, through these matching fund initiatives, we hope to further raise awareness of our foundation's good works within the community.

In 2023, our matching fund program donated an additional \$4,000 to the \$25,000 in grants issued to program participants.
